
The handsome main and guest cottages reflect a typical Georgian Bay design aesthetic; constructed with natural materials to blend into the landscape, pitched roofs with generous overhangs, spacious decking, locally quarried stone fireplaces and extensive glazing to capture views and light.



THE MAIN COTTAGE

The Main Cottage features an open plan 'Great Room' accommodating living, dining and kitchen. A screened porch links the public area to the private sleeping pod comprised of three bedrooms, 2 baths and full laundry.





The Great room features a conversation area grouped around a floor to ceiling granite fireplace, a gracious dining area with wonderful water views and a spacious, well equipped kitchen and pantry.





Extensive glazing, skylights and clerestory windows allow light to flood the interiors, the airy quality further enhanced by use of pale finishing materials; clear maple flooring and blond pine paneling.

The adjoining screen porch with sliding glass doors and walk-outs serves as a lounging, dining, games area, linking the living and sleeping areas.






Master bedroom has ensuite and private walk-out to stone patio.

THE GUEST COTTAGE

The Guest Cottage features an open plan living and dining area anchored by a floor to ceiling granite stone fireplace place, a fully equipped galley kitchen, and two bedrooms with shared 3 pc. bath. Each of the bedrooms have private walk-outs to cedar decks and an open air shower.








THE HARBOURS
